2011 RULES & REGULATIONS

PARRY'S - HAMILTON - INDOOR FARMERS' MARKET

Every item sold in the Farmers' Market must be put in a sealed bag so there is no question if it was paid for since we are in a retail setting.

If you are selling an item that Parry's is selling on consignment for you, please make sure you are selling the item for the same price as Parry's.

We do not have electric available to vendors.

The following items can be sold at Parry's Farmers' Market and are exempt from NYS Ag & Markets and need no inspection or license:

Raw fruits & vegetables, Honey & Maple Syrup (w/o added ingredients or purchased product -labeling required), Eggs (labeling required and must be refrigerated)

Miscellaneous:

Crafts or Art, must be handmade by vendor, Wine (taste testing requires proof of age), books (must be locally authored)

Must be licensed by NYS Dept of Agriculture and Markets:

Baked Goods (must be in paper or plastic packaging and homemade by vendor), Plants, Meats (NYS farm raised and slaughtered under USDA or NYSA&M with original marks of inspection intact - no repackaging and held under temperature control at all times, must be refrigerated or frozen, Dairy Products (must be from a plant licensed by the Ag & Mkts Division of Milk Control in original labeled packaging and under temperature control (at or below 41 degrees F), Fruit jams and jellies (no home canned/pickled foods allowed under generic description), Cider (must be pasteurized and from a licensed facility with labeling, must be licensed with Madison County Dept. of Health)

RULES & REGULATIONS CONTIUED

Food/Home Processors

Examples: Baked goods, fruit jams & jellies, NYS raised meat products, cider & dairy products.

Vendors selling any or all of theses items must obtain a license from NYS Department of Agriculture & Markets.

Sales Tax Registration

All vendors who are selling non-food items must charge sales tax to all customers. It is the responsibility of the vendor to obtain the sales tax permit.

Plant and Nursery Products

Examples: bedding plants, potted plants or field grown plants.

Vendors engaged in the sale of plant materials are required to be licensed in accordance with Article 14 of the NYS Agriculture and Markets Law.

Refuge/Recycling

Each vendor will be responsible for keeping their space free from all refuse during market hours. Each vendor must clean and remove all material, litter, etc. from their area when they depart. There is a recycling shed and garbage cans behind Parry's building. Vendors are free to use it as long as it is for market related garbage only.

Parking

Vendors may unload by the front door of Parry's (right side when facing building) and please park in farthest parking all the way to the right of property (when facing Parry's) with our employee parking.

I further understand that any applicant who makes false statements, representation of certification in this application shall be subject to a fine and/or revocation of their permit.
